Parents lose time at work in order to spend time with their child at the hospital and to care for him/her at home – some lose their jobs because of the time lost. This added stress puts a tremendous burden on families already trying to cope with their child's illness. We want to be able to ease that burden in any way that is needed.

The Ashley Lauren Foundation was incorporated by the State of NJ on July 6, 2005. We are a 501(c)3 non-profit organization whose mission is to bring hope and help to children in New Jersey who have been diagnosed with cancer. The Ashley Lauren Foundation was founded because of a passion to make a difference in the lives of these families. The goal of The Ashley Lauren Foundation is to ease the journey when pediatric cancer is diagnosed by providing Direct Financial Assistance (household bills, bills and medications not paid through medical insurance, traveling expenses to and from hospitals, funeral expenses, etc.); Material Assistance (food, clothing, household items); Emotional Support; Support groups; Parties for the Children; Advocacy; Outings; Birthday and Holiday Gifts for the Children; our "Making Dreams Come True" Program and anything else that is needed to make their lives easier and to let each child know that they are important to us. We do not fund research but rather
